Future Art Masters Exhibition (FAME)

National Call for Entries:

The American Artists Professional League, Inc. (AAPL) is a national organization dedicated to recognizing, encouraging and promoting traditional, realistic fine art in America since 1928.

1. WORKS ELIGIBLE:

Open to all art students attending senior class in High School and under graduates of accredited colleges and all art schools and institutes. Up to three entries per student may be submitted for selection in the same media only; however, only one entry per artist will be accepted. Works only in Representational or Traditional Realism will be considered. Original oil, acrylic, watermedia, mixed media, pastel and sculpture.

There will be two classes for submitting work: (1) Senior high school students, degree seeking undergraduate students attending accredited colleges. And, (2) students of continuing art education school and institutes.

Image must be submitted in the following format:

2. RESTRICTIONS:

Photo-Lithographs and computer generated artwork are not eligible.

3. METHOD OF SUBMISSION:

Entries must be submitted online in JPEG or PNG format with a resolution of 300 dpi, 1,200 pixels on the longest dimension. Image should show only painting or sculpture – no backgrounds, mats or frames. Sculpture, please send two views.

FAME art work must be submitted online at www.aaplinc.org Payment can be PayPal, Credit Card or a Check sent to:

Your work will be considered pending until the printed invoice and your check are received.

If you have any problems with uploading your image or want to change the entry image, contact office@aaplinc.org. We will delete

your image. Then you may upload another without charge.

4. ENTRY DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION:

All online entries and payments must be received by May 16, 2015.

5. ENTRY FEE:

A fee of \$20.00 for first entry, \$5.00 for each additional submission - maximum of three entries. There will be no refunds for rejected works.

6. ACCEPTED ARTISTS:

All accepted artists will be eligible for Cash and Merchandise Awards, will receive a Studiosum Membrum (studio-sum memb-room) card with student membership benefits, and will receive a personalized letter of acceptance from the AAPL President. Also, accepted artists will be listed the AAPL Grand National catalog.

Awards will be given in two categories:

1. Senior high school students, degree seeking undergraduate students attending accredited colleges perusing the traditional tract will be eligible for an AAPL scholarship based on our IRC 501(c) (3) conditions and acknowledged by an accredited art institution. Monetary scholarship awards will go towards tuition unless there is a situation of hardship.

2. Awards and prizes will be given to students of continuing art education schools and institutes.

7. ARTIST SUBMISSION AGREEMENT:

By submitting an image of your work, if accepted by the Jury of Selection, and you hereby agree and acknowledge the terms and conditions set forth in this Prospectus. Your Payment will constitute that I have read and understand the entry instructions.
